



Cornerstone Concrete Limited Warranty

Every driveway we install is backed by Cornerstone Concrete's Limited Warranty. The Cornerstone Concrete Limited Warranty applies for 3 years from the day your concrete is poured. If we are unable to service warranty work during the current season, we will service you the following year, even if your warranty expires during the delay.

Prior to the start of any warranty work, the initial installation must be paid for in full. Any invoice that is past due 60 days or more will automatically void the warranty. The customer will be required to sign a release waiver verifying the work to be performed. Cornerstone Concrete LLC and its suppliers will be released from any further liability. No work can be performed without a signed waiver.

In addressing warranty issues, a section is defined as the concrete within the control joints. Our warranty covers section sizes up to 6' x 6'. **Warranties are non transferrable.*

The following is a list of what is covered:

- **Pop Outs:** Any section that has 10 or more pop outs greater than or equal to $\frac{3}{8}$ " will resolved with a drill and fill or professional overlay product.
- **Scaling and Mortar Flaking:** Any section(s)* that has 10% or greater surface area of scaling or mortar flaking damage will be resolved with a professional grade overlay product.
- **Cracks:** If a dime can be inserted into a crack to a depth of half its diameter or more, we will replace the affected section(s)*. *The dime must be able to slide into a stretch of the crack where there is no chipping.* Likewise, if a height difference of more than 3/4" develops along a crack or control joint (this does not apply to where the driveway meets the garage or road.) when the ground is frost-free (NOT during the winter months), we will replace the affected section(s)*. When concrete sections are replaced, we are not responsible for damaged edges on adjacent sections.

The following issues are NOT covered by the Cornerstone Concrete Limited Warranty:

- **Color Differences:** Color differences between existing and replacement concrete, and between different pours of concrete during initial installation. Integral colored concrete's final color after curing is not guaranteed to match the sample that is was picked from. Any color manipulation after it is poured is at the homeowners expense.
- **Frost Heaving:** Minnesota and Wisconsin are in a severe weather region. Throughout any given winter there are many freeze-thaw cycles. During these events your concrete may heave up but will likely settle back to its normal height.
- **Physical Damage:** Marks from ice chippers, shovels, snowplows, construction equipment, heavy commercial trucks, etc. The warranty is void for sections exhibiting such damage.
- **Stains:** Stains of any kind are not covered.
- **Driveway Approach:** A driveway approach is the first 6' of concrete adjacent to a street or the first 3' adjacent to an alley. Because your driveway approach is subject to deicing chemicals distributed by snowplows, we do not warranty pop out, scaling or flaking in the driveway approach area.
